



Lawrie Cherniack practises at the firm Cherniack & Cherniack Law Corporation devoting his practice solely to conflict resolution. He has been an adjudicator hearing claims of sexual and physical abuse at Indian Residential Schools through the Independent Assessment Process since 2009.

He was a partner in the law firm of Cherniack Smith from 1985 to 2006. Before that, he was an associate, and then a partner, in the law firm of Skwark Myers, practising in all areas of the law. He focused mainly on administrative and labour law, and has acted on behalf of unions and employees since 1975. He has appeared before many administrative tribunals, numerous arbitration boards, the Manitoba and Canada labour boards, all the courts of Manitoba, and the Supreme Court of Canada. He has also acted as Chair of numerous arbitration tribunals, and was Vice-Chair of the Manitoba Labour Board, and of the Manitoba Human Rights Commission, and Chair of the City of Winnipeg Act Review Committee.

He has created and taught many courses involving administrative and labour law, negotiation, arbitration, and strategy across Canada, for the Public Service Commission of Saskatchewan, Alberta community colleges, administrative tribunals in Manitoba, the Industrial Relations Institute, the Arbitration and Mediation Institutes of Manitoba and Saskatchewan, various unions, Nunavut College, and the University of Manitoba.

He was a founding coordinator of the Winnipeg Free University in the late 1960's, a community organizer and group facilitator for the Institute of Urban Studies at the University of Winnipeg in the late 1960's to early 1970's, and a City of Winnipeg Councillor in the early 1970's.

He has been on boards and executive of numerous community organizations and has a Bachelor of Arts from Carleton College in Minnesota, a Master of Arts from the University of Chicago, and an LL.B. from the University of Manitoba. The ADR Institute of Canada certified him as a Chartered Arbitrator in 1996, and a Chartered Mediator in 2007. He received a Certificate in Conflict Resolution specializing in Mediation from Mediation Services of Manitoba in 2005.
